ORIENTATION SHEET

1. You may be discharged from the program without credit and with no refund for any of the following reasons:

- A. If you are late or absent for any reason. The Texas Department of State Health Services requires that you attend every minute of the program with no exceptions. If you are late or absent, the reason for either will not be considered. There are no makeup sessions.
B. If you are not available to participate in an exit interview immediately following the last class session.
C. If you fail to make a minimum score of 70% on a written exam, you will not receive a Certificate of Completion.
D. If you are under 18 years of age and seen on the property* with tobacco or tobacco products.
E. If you smoke in the building.
F. If you are seen on the property with alcohol or drugs, or have alcohol on your breath.
G. If you commit any vandalism, play in or around the building, play any pranks, play in the elevator, are rude to people or block their passage on the premises.
H. If you are disruptive in class.

2. If you are discharged from the program without credit, your options are as follows:

- ⊗ You start over at registration, including paying the complete registration fee once again.
⊗ You return to court for alternate sentencing.

- 3. Arrive at the times and dates as printed on the bottom of your copy of the registration form.
4. Those who are compliant and pass the test will receive a certificate of completion at the end of the program.
5. There is a \$25 replacement fee for a lost certificate.
6. This program provides only education and information, with no mental health services provided or implied.
